

Cub Scouts Pack 163 FAQ

Who can join?

Cub Scout Pack 163 is open to boys and girls from grades K through 5. Most, but not all, of our scouts are students at Jefferson Elementary School (where we hold our pack meetings)

How much does it cost?

\$95 per year for registration (2018-19 season). There is also a one-time \$15 fee for uniform (t-shirt, vest, and neck-kerchief). Checks can be made out to "Pack 163"

What does the fees cover?

About 2/3 of the fees are paid to the Boy Scouts of America organization to cover insurance costs, etc. In addition, each season your scout will receive a book, neckerchief & Pinewood Derby car. Your scout will also receive many awards (pins, patches, belt-loops) throughout the year. In addition, many of our events & activities are free of charge. Your scout will also receive a T-shirt and fleece vest which he/she will wear throughout their time in scouts

How long does the season last?

Scouting Season lasts September through June (school year) and we also have a few summer activities (like a baseball game & sleepover on the outfield in tents!)

How often are meetings held?

There are usually one or two den meetings and/or activities per month. There are also one or two pack meetings and/or activities per month. Plan on approximately 3-4 gatherings per month.

What is a "Den"? A small group all in the same grade/scout level

What is a "Pack"? The entire group including 1st thru 5th graders

As a parent, what is my involvement?

A parent is required to attend meetings and gatherings as many of the activities will be working together with your child. You are encouraged to participate as much as possible and there are many opportunities to volunteer at the den and pack level

I may have a scheduling conflict, are siblings welcome?

Siblings are welcome to almost all meetings & activities. Sometimes the leaders may integrate them into activities if possible. However, we do ask that you help out if they get disruptive (it's a good idea to bring a quiet activity for them) since the leader's primary focus is on the Cub Scouts
